



LAKEMONT CLUB HANDBOOK

Regulations governing the use of the pool, tennis courts and grounds are under the control of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors has authorized the Lakemont Staff (including Lifeguards) to limit or prohibit such conduct or activities on the premises as the Staff may deem to create unreasonable risk of injury, damage, or otherwise not be in the best interest of the Club. All federal, state and local laws shall be applicable on Club property.

All persons using the Club facilities do so at their own risk. The Club shall not be held responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with such use, including, but not limited to: participation in any and all recreational, athletic or sporting events, contests or exhibitions held at and/or sponsored by Lakemont Club, Inc. The safety of minors is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.

unless participating in authorized activities, no person shall be allowed in the pool area before or after hours.

CLUB RULES

1.	Club privileges are limited to those who have met all of their membership obligations and are considered in good standing with the Board of Directors. Members shall be held financially responsible for any damages they or their guests cause to Club property.
2.	All Firearms, including concealed handguns, shall be prohibited on Club property.
3.	At no time will anyone under the age of 18 use the Pool unless a qualified lifeguard is on duty.
4.	Lifeguards are responsible for the safety and conduct of the people in the Pool and the Pool Area. Members shall obey the Staff at all times. No member may reprimand any Staff at any time; all complaints shall be directed to the Pool Manager. The Pool Manager (or designee) is authorized to expel anyone from the property who disobeys these Rules. Parents shall be notified immediately if their child has been expelled and no child shall be sent off Club property without parental notification.
5.	No one is to distract the lifeguards while on duty watching the Pool. Lifeguard stands are for lifeguards ONLY.
6.	All members are responsible for their guests as per our GUEST POLICY.
7.	No glass or ceramics shall be permitted within the pool fence.
8.	No food or drink shall be allowed in the water.
9.	The Club prohibits profanity of any kind on Club property.
10.	There shall be no running in the Pool Area. The following are prohibited in the Pool and Tennis Areas: bike/scooter riding; skating/skateboarding; wrestling/fighting or excessive horseplay. All bicycles shall be parked in the provided bike rack.
11.	Persons who pose a threat to the public health shall not be allowed in the Pool.
12.	Swimmers shall wear suitable bathing attire; cut-offs of any kind are prohibited. Young children who are not toilet trained shall wear approved swim diapers.
13.	A parent or guardian must accompany their child in Toddler Pool Area at all times. NO CHILD SHALL BE UNATTENDED IN THE TODDLER POOL at any time.

14.	Toddler Pool and accompanying Toddler Play Area are reserved for children 6 years and younger.
15.	Children under the age of 10 shall not be permitted on Club property unless accompanied by a person 13 years of age or older. Responsibility of the person accompanying the child to the Club continues while the child remains on Club property. Child Members over the age of 10 may visit the Club unattended at the discretion of the Pool Manager and Staff. All permitted unaccompanied children shall have an Emergency Contact form on file with the Club Manager.
16.	Floats/ rafts/ snorkels/ masks/ fins are to be permitted at the discretion of the lifeguards. Hanging on the Pool ropes is prohibited.
17.	Diving is allowed in the deep end only. No other activity is allowed in the Diving Well when the Diving Board is in use.
18.	Only one person is allowed on the Diving Board at a time and there is a maximum weight limit of 225 pounds. All dives are to be made straight ahead and divers must clear the diving well immediately by way of the ladder.
19.	No climbing is permitted on top of the Club's building structures or fences. The Pump Room and <i>Snack Shack</i> are restricted to Authorized Personnel only.
20.	At 10 minutes to the hour, every hour, the Pool will be cleared of all persons under the age of 18 for a rest period lasting 10 minutes. Lifeguards may clear the Pool of all swimmers at any time for a safety check. In the event of thunder and/or lightning, Lifeguards shall clear both pools of all swimmers for a period lasting 30 minutes from the last thunder strike.
21.	Lounge chairs are reserved for the adults at the Pool.
22.	The Pool and Toddler Pool will be CLOSED for Home Swim Meets.
23.	Members shall dispose of their trash and recycling in appropriate bins.
24.	Members shall clean up after their pets on Club property. Pets are prohibited in the Pool Area.
25.	The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
26.	All motorized vehicles, including mopeds, are to be kept in the Parking Lot. They are not permitted on any grassy area or walking path. The only exception to this rule is Swim Meets or other organized events that necessitate over-flow parking.
27.	No individual other than those contractual agents of the Club may teach swimming lessons or tennis lessons for a profit at Lakemont Club.
28.	Only appropriate court shoes shall be worn on the tennis courts. The court shall not be used when wet.
29.	Smoking, vaping, and all tobacco and tobacco related products are prohibited on Club grounds.
30.	Interested Members shall sign up and pay the appropriate entry fees in advance for Club sponsored tournaments and round-robins.
31.	Tennis Programs contracted through Lakemont Club shall take precedent over court reservations. Non-members may participate in tennis clinics and leagues when space is available.
32.	Tennis Court lights shall not be used after 10 pm.
33.	Food and drinks other than water are not permitted within the fenced area of the Tennis Courts.

GUEST POLICY

	ALL MEMBERS are responsible for filling out a guest form and paying for their guests at the <i>Snack Shack</i> upon arrival. Your guest must be paid for and marked by the staff at the <i>Snack Shack</i> before entering the Pool Area and/or Tennis Courts.
	ALL GUESTS must be accompanied by a member and must leave the Club premises when the member leaves.
	MEMBERS are responsible for their guests and should inform their guests of Club rules and responsibilities.
	FEES for in-town guests are \$5 per person with a maximum fee of \$15 per family. A punch card for 10 guests to visit at various times for the season may be purchased for \$20. There is no guest fee for those who reside outside of Wake County.
	GUESTS shall be limited to a total of 2 visits per week.

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

Children under the age of 10 shall not be permitted on Club property unless accompanied by a person 13 years of age or older. Responsibility of the person accompanying the child to the Club continues while the child remains on Club property. Child Members 10 years of age and older may visit the Club unattended at the discretion of the Pool Manager and Staff.

All strikes will be noted in a file and be made available to parents/guardians. In the event the above expectations are continually violated, I understand the Pool Manager reserves the right to revoke said child's privilege of unattended visitations for a time set forth by the Pool Manager. The Pool Manager has full Board authorization to act at his/her discretion. *No child shall be removed from club property without parent/guardian notification.*

PAVILION RESERVATIONS

Members can rent the Pavilion for parties and other social events during normal operating hours. \$50 payable to Lakemont Pool entitles members to exclusive Pavilion access for 2 hours. 15 guests are included in this fee for the duration of the party. Additional guests may be added as per the fees laid out in our Guest Policy. (Gazebo may be rented for \$35 to include 10 guests). Reservations must be made in advance with the Pool Manager.
